Limón Dance Company

Pushing seventy-five years old, the company founded by José Limón soldiers on with a new artistic director, Dante Puleio, who took over in July. Dec. 19 offers a chance to see what shape the troupe is in with a free live-streamed performance from the Kaatsbaan Cultural Center. The program supplements two of Limón's most famous works—"The Moor's Pavane" (his 1949 take on "Othello") and his humanist classic "There Is a Time," from 1956—with "Suite Donuts," a new bauble by Chafin Seymour.
